**Subject: Notification under Article 10(2) of the
Commission Regulation (EU) No 965/2012 of
5 October 2012 laying down technical
requirements and administrative procedures
related to air operations pursuant to
Regulation (EC) No 216/2008 of the European
Parliament and of the Council**

In line with Article 10(2) of the Commission Regulation (EU) No 965/2012 of 5 October 2012 laying down technical requirements and administrative procedures related to air operations pursuant to Regulation (EC) No 216/2008 of the European Parliament and of the Council, the Republic of Latvia has decided to make use of the whole opt-out period.

In discharging State's obligations to ICAO and considering the complexity of the European Aviation Safety System, the Republic of Latvia distinguishes a need for a clear prioritisation of tasks for the definition of an acceptable level of safety performance.

Civil Aviation Agency of the Republic of Latvia (Hereinafter- LV CAA) also needs to survey its planning system on the availability of personnel, in order to ensure the proper completion of all tasks.

LV CAA shall identify all changes that affect its capability to perform its tasks and discharge its responsibilities as defined in Regulation (EC) No 216/2008 and its Implementing Rules.

Implementation of the organisations' Management Systems according to ORO.GEN.200 depends on the appropriate activities carried out by the LV CAA on the implementation of Annex II Part-ARO requirements.

Therefore, the Republic of Latvia has decided not to apply the provisions of Annexes I to V until 28 October 2014.

LV CAA has not issued air operator certificates to commercial air transport operators of helicopters before the Commission Regulation (EU) No 965/2012 applies, therefore the establishment of conversion report according to Article 7(2) of the Commission Regulation (EU) No 965/2012 has not been prepared by the competent authority.

LV CAA has prepared a programme containing actions envisaged and related timing for the implementation of the Commission Regulation (EU) No 965/2012.

You are kindly requested to comment our draft implementation plan.
